- (4) They will not attempt to identify individual participants from whom the EUROTAST Genotype Data were obtained;
- (5) They will not sell any of the data obtained from EUROTAST DAC. The data will not be used for commercial purposes, profit, or patents;
- (6) They will not share any of the data obtained from controlled-access EUROTAST Genotype Data with individuals other than those named in the data access request. If another researcher wants access to the data, they must request it directly and go through the same institutionally approved data sharing procedure;
- (7) They will report any violation of the policy to the appropriate EUROTAST DAC as soon as it is discovered.
